



COVID-19 IMPACT REPORT

In the last one month, The Elevation Church has evolved various impact initiatives to provide nutritional, medical, emotional and mental health support to our communities.

Through our small groups system, we have distributed over 2,000 food bags to church members while also ensuring that over 6,000 non-TEC members across 17 Local Government Areas in Lagos received food bags comprising of 5kg rice, 5kg beans, 6kg garri, 140g tomato puree and 1.5 litre vegetable oil and more through our social impact organization, Pistis Foundation in partnership with GIG logistics.

Similarly, 7 people have benefited from our medical intervention in partnership with St. Kizito's Clinic Lekki and Chion Hospital Maryland and this includes the delivery of a baby boy! The Elevation Church medical team has also attended to about 50 church members via telemedicine over the period.

To support our internal and external communities, we have partnered with the Institute for Family Engineering and Development to provide professional counselling support to those who need same at this time.

We thank everyone who has been a part of making all these happen in cash or in kind.

We enjoin all residents of Lagos and Nigerians at this time, to remain health conscious and observe the safety guidelines approved by established healthcare agencies, to protect our lives and flatten the curve of the Covid-19 pandemic in Nigeria.
